

# TERMS AND CONDITIONS

## 1. Release of liability

Participant will enter the camp in good health and condition. Participant understands that participating in the Champions Factory Squash Camp's physical and other activities involves risks, without limitation, death, serious neck and spinal injuries resulting in complete or partial paralysis, heart attacks, and injury to bones, joints, or muscles. Participant confirms that Participant is voluntarily participating in Champions Factory Squash Camp's physical and other activities with knowledge of these risks involved. Participant or Participant's legal representatives, release Champions Factory Squash Camp's organizers, contractors and camp leaders, representatives and invitees from any and all claims and demands which Participant may have or hereafter acquire for any and all damages, injuries or losses which may be suffered or sustained by Participant in connection with the Champions Factory Squash Camp or any of its related activities.

## 2. Payment and refund

**PAYMENTS:** All camp fees are due with registration form on or before two weeks before the squash camp's first day.

**EXCEPTIONS:** Fees are NON-REFUNDABLE except as for cancellation within two weeks of submitting the registration form and at least two weeks prior to the first day of the squash camp.

## 3. Code of Conduct

Champions Factory Squash Camp participants are expected to be committed and show a positive and enthusiastic attitude at all times; they are expected to be respectful to all coaches and peer participants. Champions Factory Squash Camp organizers wish to emphasize that smoking, drinking alcohol and the use of drugs is strictly prohibited at all times.

### *a. Behaviour*

All participants are expected to behave in a correct manner; in the event that a participant's behaviour does not meet our standards, the coaching and camp organization staff will make every effort to correct misbehaviour, and in those cases where misconduct continues, Champions Factory Squash Camp organizers reserve the right to dismiss participants from the camp at the parents' expense without a refund of their payment.

### *b. The use of Drugs, Alcohol and Smoking Tobacco*

Champions Factory Squash Camp organizers will immediately dismiss from the program at the parents' expense without a refund of the program payment anyone caught drinking alcohol or having alcohol in their possession during their stay at the camp. Any participant caught using, selling, buying or distributing drugs ( with the exception of prescription medications ) will be dismissed from the camp at the parents' expense without a refund of the program payment. Any participant caught smoking tobacco ( in any form ), selling tobacco ( in any form ), purchasing tobacco ( in any form ) will be dismissed from the camp at the parents' expense without a refund of the program payment.
